In just under a month you will be welcomed to the new Midland Impact so today I enclose all your final detail. In this pack you should have....

Arrivals Bands / Corps

All vehicles should approach the venue via the A428 Rugby Road (see map). Please note that as you leave the A46 traffic island onto the A428 the turning into Broadstreet RFC is immediately on your left and is very easily passed.

Upon Arrival

Please follow the instructions of the parking marshals who will direct you to your spot for the duration of your stay. All vehicles will be parked at the owners risk and please ensure you let the marshals know when you intend to leave if it is not straight after your final muster. Band / Corps members must remain with their vehicles until wrist bands have been issued.

The Band Master / Corps Director must then report to band reception (see site layout) to register the Band / Corps arrival, which will open at 8.30 am. Please ensure you have with you

Band registration form, highlighting the day's marching members (back field head count will be done)

Staff registration form, highlighting the day's attending staff members

Judges tapes, clearly labelled with caption and Band / Corps name

Announcer details, to be read out after the performance

In addition, if you have qualified for Critique (see Order of Play sheet) please confirm if you still intend to attend.

Wrist bands will be issued to all the marching members and registered staff as per BYBA rules, but please note these will be band passes not spectator passes. Please instruct your staff and members that the wrist bands provided will not get them into the main stand as the stand is for paying supporters only. Additional staff passes and upgrades can be purchased from reception. Anyone not showing a wristband will be escorted to reception.

Spectators

Need to report to the spectator entrance to purchase a coloured wrist band that will allow them access to the stadium and main stand.

Stadium & Stand

Access to stadium area will only be allowed after 8.30am. Spectators should not block the entry/exit or stairways and should be seated during performances.

Arena

The arena is a grass surface and will be marked out as per BYBA rules. No equipment is to be dragged on the arena with the exception of wheeled pit equipment. Entrance and exit to the arena is from the rear corner side one. The pit will enter and exit by the front corner side one. Please note that arena marshal's instructions are final.

Practice Area

Marching practice only may take place on any of the surrounding grass pitches but please be aware of moving traffic near to the pit area.

Tune up

This is in a designated area at an allocated time (see site layout & order of play). Bands / Corps will be lead from their vehicles to tune up and then to the back of the arena by a MI Marshal. Please wait for a marshal to meet you at your changing area and do not make your own way to the warm up area as this caused a problem last year.

Band Performance Times

Please ensure you arrive on site and are ready for your assembly time in advance of the timetable. You will then be met by a MI Marshal. Any time changes on the day will be detailed upon your arrival to reception.

Band tapes

These will be available from band reception 15 minutes after your performance. Please listen to tapes before critique.

Score sheets

These will be available to all from band reception 10 minutes after the end of muster at a cost of 20p each.

Final Parade

All bands are required to meet on the practice pitches (see site layout) 10 minutes before commencement of the final muster. A nominated band will play everyone on and the winning band of each class will play their class off, to a constant 110-120 beats per minute.

Critique

Only the first 16 bands to enter any BYBA show will qualify for Critique. Please check the show schedule to save confusion on the day. Critique will be after each final muster on a first come first served basis and held in a room just off band reception near to the bar (see site layout). It is a requirement to listen to tapes before critique.

Refreshments

There will be drinks and food available all day from the club house. A licensed bar will also be available all day on site. Any drink related issues from members or staff may result in their Band / Corps being disqualified from the day's competition.

First Aid

Cover will be provided by Medic One who will be situated in the pit hold area (see site layout).

Booster Stalls

These will require advance booking and will be expected to be set up between 8.00 - 9.00am.

Health & Safety

An event safety plan is available from reception on request.

Smoking

No smoking will be allowed in the buildings which are covered by the July 2007 smoking legislation. In addition, it will be requested not to smoke in the spectators stand for the comfort of others.

Toilets

These are available in the club house, please leave them as you would expect to find them.

Litter

Please use the provided bins on site.

Liability

Please note that the organisers will not be held responsible for the damage, loss or theft of any equipment or personal belonging on the day. The event is covered by BYBA public Liability insurance.

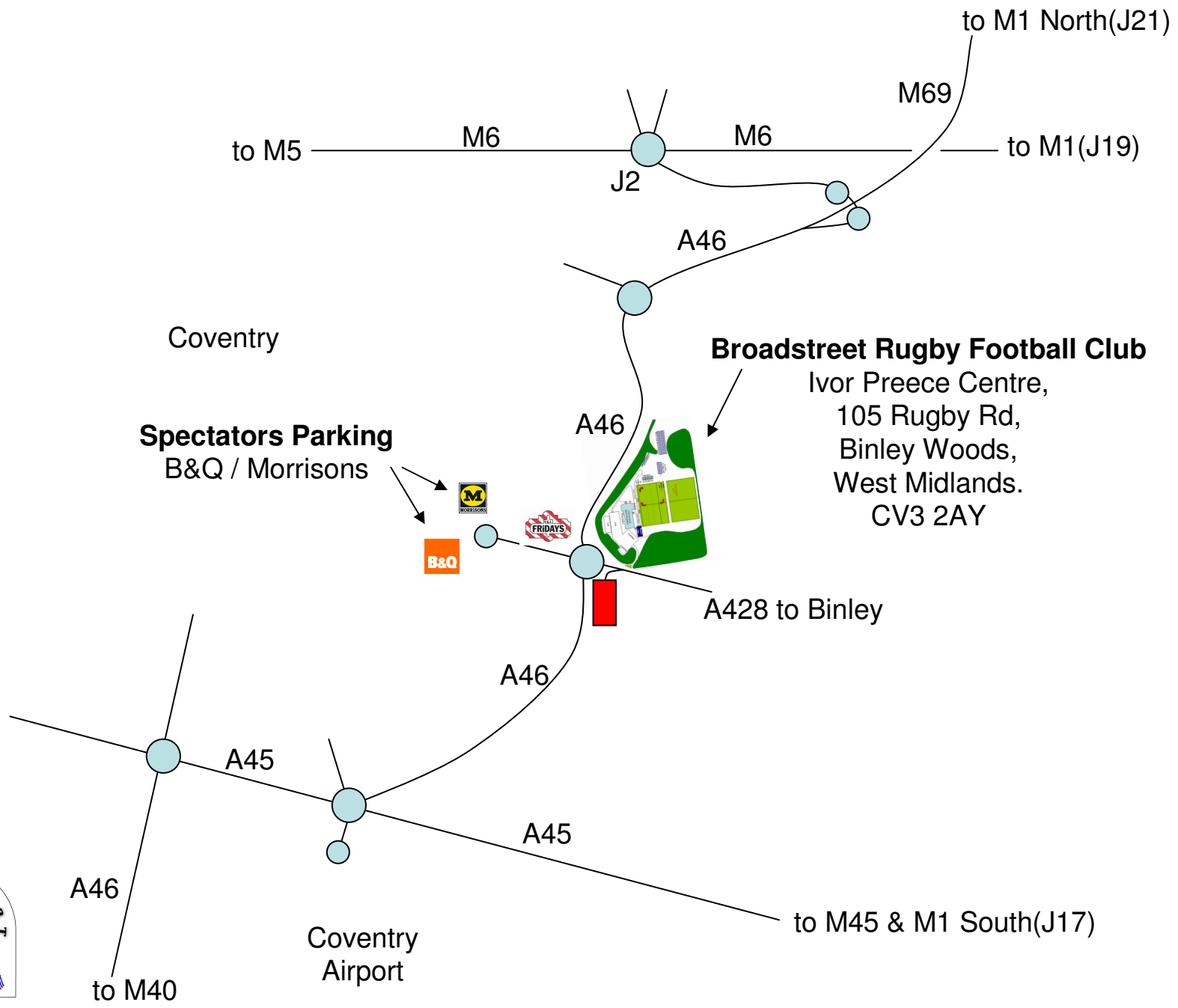

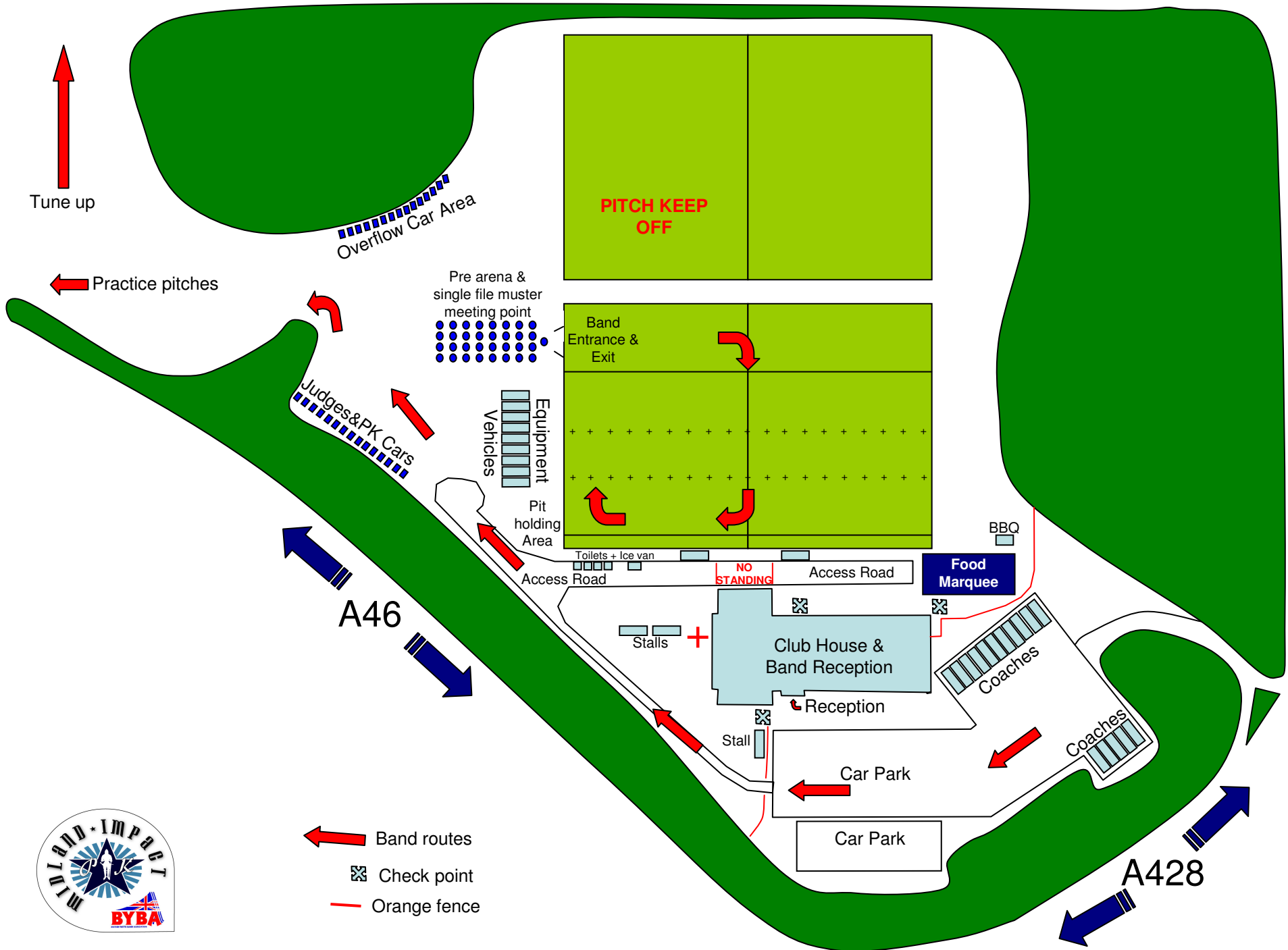
